Arabists claim the same skills as the graduates in French and think **they** are excluded from the socio- professional circuit. Arabic speakers have many difficulties to work in the civil service. The government has not developed specific strategies for their socio professional integration. However, according to Inspector Mor Talla Cissé, efforts are being made to address the problem of Arab-- Islamic education.

He agrees that Arabic speakers should diversify their studies taking into account the realities and social changes happening in Senegal. He invites **them** to a perfect mastery of languages, especially French. If they follow training courses that give opportunities on the labour market, they will surely succeed in their professional integration. While awaiting an appropriate solution to the question of the socio professional integration of the Arab- speaking elite in the labour market, it turns out that the latter has its needs that the academic training of Arabic speaking people today could not satisfy.
