## Gaza: Death is all over

The Israeli occupation has wiped out whole neighborhoods in Gaza. There was a huge bombing near my house. We had to flee our home in the middle of the night. I had to take my children and run. 26 people have died, many more are under the rubble.

Hospitals are running out of medical supplies and beds. Dead bodies are on the ground. Most of **them** are women and children. Israeli warplanes have bombed homes, mosques and agricultural lands. We have neither water nor electricity. We charge our phones using solar panels. There is sometimes internet if I use a mobile phone, but the connection is only for two minutes.

No place is safe in Gaza. Israeli told people to move southward and bombs are still falling there. While I'm writing this, there is a bombing, and an attack on a civilian car. I use Twitter to share information about what is happening.

The occupiers violate our rights and the laws of freedom. We have been living in an open-air prison for seventy years .They control us as **they** please, kill us whenever they please and cut off our supplies, electricity and water. We only demand freedom and our rights.
