### Major Security Boost in Response to Rising Violence

In response to the recent surge in murders during July and August, especially in Dakar and its suburbs, the Minister of Interior and Public Security has announced significant measures to strengthen security. During a press conference, he outlined a plan to substantially increase the presence of law enforcement in the areas most affected by this violence.

Dakar and its surrounding regions have experienced a troubling rise in violent crimes over **the past two months**, leading to growing concern among their population. "The safety of our citizens is our top priority, and we must take firm action to address this situation," said the Minister. His projects include an increase in police patrols, the deployment of special forces to high-risk neighbourhoods, and better coordination with intelligence services.

- 10 The minister also stressed the importance of public cooperation with law enforcement. "Security is everyone's responsibility," he stated, encouraging citizens to report any suspicious activities. <u>This</u> is essential to assist investigations and prevent further crimes. In addition to these measures, the minister emphasized the need to re-evaluate current security strategies. "We must adapt our methods to effectively respond to this wave of violence," he added.
- 15 The response to these announcements has been mixed, with some people welcoming the initiative and **others** calling for even stricter actions to restore safety. Nevertheless, this plan represents a key step in the government's efforts to ensure the safety of all citizens in the country. The Minister hopes that these actions will help reverse the trend and restore a sense of security and trust among the citizens.
