Jakarta taxis or "tiak tiak", a new means of transport in Dakar

Dakar is becoming like Bamako or Ouagadougou. The number of Jakarta taxis as a means of transport for city dwellers is increasing more and more, despite the governor's order banning this mode of transport in the region. We see them in front of banks, bus stations and under bridges waiting for customers. They operate clandestinely without helmets or insurance, slipping through traffic jams almost everywhere.

The difficulties of travelling in Dakar have popularized this means of transport. Many people use Jakarta taxis to deliver a package on record time or travel. A demand that drives more and more young people to enter the sector. Consequently, it has become difficult to drive in Dakar due to endless traffic jams. Motorists who use the VDN are well aware of the ordeal of traffic jams, especially at rush hours.

Some Jakarta taxi drivers do not even know how to drive, causing serious accidents. According to 2022 statistics from the National Fire Brigade, 3,000 people in Jakarta taxis were hit by vehicles, causing 118 deaths. 1,569 collisions between Jakarta caused 25 deaths and 2,390 slips and falls caused 47 deaths. Some motorists interviewed said deaths are higher than that. Instead of raising awareness among young people about this scourge, some politicians continue to pay Jakarta taxis for young people.

In the past, immigration was the main cause of school dropout, now it is the Jakarta business. Many young people guit school to make money in this sector, not to mention the overwhelming majority of young people entering the job market each year.
